We invited Mr. Billy Yau to come to talk to our S3, S5 and S6 students in the School Hall on 9 September 2021. He is the first teacher who is blind in Hong Kong. He completely lost his sight at the age of two; however, with dogged perseverance he graduated from the University of Hong Kong with a degree in education in 2008. After graduation, he served as an English teacher, and has taught writing to some of our S5 and S6 students. During the talk, he shared his experience in learning and in life, and spread the message of staying strong and determined in adversity, which echos with our aim of promoting positive education and a growth mindset.
